'Our commitment to responsible manufacturing'

ENVIRONMENTAL

Recyclable packaging - We have made changes to the way we package our print using only recyclable materials. We have become plastic free too!

Carbon Net Zero Target - We are committed to achieving this goal by 2050 and are actively tracking our emissions so we can see areas where we need to improve. We work with an external organisation to calculate our emissions and set realistic targets. Our factory has been converted to using LED lighting to become more energy efficient and are our suppliers are chosen with sustainability in mind.

The Woodland Trust and Forest Carbon - We have partnership programmes with both organisations meaning all the materials we buy are carbon offset with the planting of native trees here in the UK. All our paper comes from managed forests.

Waste - Our waste paper is either re-used in-house as jotter pads, packing or if end of life has been reached, it is sent to be recycled. Our chemical waste is disposed of safely, recycled with no pollution to waterways. All other waste is processed and used to generate energy by our waste management company. Nothing is sent to landfill.

Recycled Paper - Much hype surrounds recycled paper and we have partnered up with Two Sides and their Love Paper campaign to bust these myths. Ask to see a copy of our leaflet for more information. We do work with a variety of recycled papers and all our papers are from responsibly managed sources.

Green Space - We have converted our unused outside space to become a green space for staff and the local wildlife. We planted 40 hedgerow trees as part of the Queen's Canopy project and we are doing our bit to encourage insects and birds to our corner of the industrial estate.

SOCIAL

Workplace Garden - As well as helping the wildlife, our garden provides a green space for staff to enjoy and as a place to host summer social events. We are all enjoying contributing to it!

The Printing Charity - We have the support of the charity who provide a 24 hour helpline to our staff for any matters that may arise in life. They supply us with valuable advice and support as well as help! to encourage the next generation of printers.

Our Local Community - Located in a Breckland market town, we are here to provide print and design services to local businesses, organisations and individuals but also to get involved in the community. We are a sponsor of Thetford Rugby Club and work with the town council on various community events.

Young People in Print

Encouraging young people into our industry is very important. We are looking into initiatives to help with this like supporting the BPIF's Apprenticeship Champion Network. We can also offer work experience to young people interested in print.

GOVERNANCE

ISO Certification - We are proud to maintain ISO14001 and ISO9001 meaning we are compliant in environmental and management working practices. We are regularly audited.

BPIF - Membership with the British Print Industry Federation means we have guidance and advice at our fingertips alongside access to training, apprenticeships and a shoulder to lean upon when we need it.

The Book Chain Project - Rollmark is signed up to this organisation which provides the publishing industry with a code of conduct that ensures all suppliers meet recognised standards for labour and environmental practices.

Help the birds and the bees by planting our seeded paper!
This can be printed on one side and is made of 100% recycled paper, fibres and cotton. Ideal for smaller sized projects avoiding full ink coverage. Plant between May and September.

- 1. Soak the paper in water overnight
- 2. Cover with a thin layer of compost and keep moist
- Can be planted indoors or outside but avoid frosts! Germination should take approx. 7-10 days.
- 4. Send us a picture of your wild flowers!
